TOMMY CULLY RIP

It is with mixed emotions of pride and sadness that I write these few words on the occasion of Tommy Cully's memorial show. Proud of having known him and great sadness at his passing.

Tommy was a trail blazer of his time. As far back as the 60's he visited the English National in London and brought over birds for fellow fanciers to compete. He was particularly well known throughout England and Wales and had judged at many of the leading shows there such as, English National, British border, Merseyside and Cleveland. He also judged at most of our shows throughout Ireland. Tommy was a great organizer of events such as trips to North Wales BFCC, the British BFCC and Merseyside BFCC. Who can forget the trips to Rhyl, Winsford, Fleetwood and Blackpool and of course "The Woodpecker Hotel".

He particularly enjoyed the British Border club Annual dinner at the Kimberly hotel Blackpool and attended for several years. He was Secretary of the Irish Border club for many years. In the early days he would be first there to light the fire when the meetings were held in the Plasterers hall, Essex St. Later the meetings were held North Great Charles St., Boland's Social Club and for many years in The Workman's Club. Tommy had been there throughout those years and our Club was always close to his heart. He had seen entries rise from around 300 to a record breaking 1000 plus entry at our Jubilee Show.

All of his life Tommy gave generously of his time and energy to the club. He will always be remembered as someone who was more than willing to help his fellow fanciers, especially novices and working tirelessly on behalf of the Irish Border Fancy Canary Club.

We are all a little bit richer for having knowing him, and all a little poorer for his passing

Rest In Peace Tommy.

SHOW RULES

- 1 The Committee will take the greatest care of exhibits but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and purchasers that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss or damage to any exhibit or cage either during or in transit to or from the Show.
- 2 Entries to be made on printed form which can be had from the Show Secretary and must be lodged with him on or before 15th October. The full amount of entry fees must, in all cases, accompany entries. The committee reserve the power to refuse any entry or entries without assigning any reason. In which case the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will the entry fee be refunded.
- 3 Exhibitors are requested to exercise every care when classifying their entries. Entries entered in the wrong class will be deemed 'Wrong Classed'. Exhibits cannot be re-classed after catalogue is printed. Wrongly classed birds will not be eligible to compete for specials.
- 4 All exhibits must be bona-fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry and any exhibit purchased from a judge officiating at the show cannot be exhibited unless such exhibit has been in the exhibitors' possession at least 6 months prior to the show.
- 5 Exhibitors should describe the exhibit to ensure proper classification. They may also name a price (cage not included) at which they will sell their exhibit; the committee being empowered to sell at such price. All sales must be made through the committee. The Committee reserve the right to refuse to sell a bird at catalogue price if a mistake has been made through printer's error. Sales shall be made through entry form only. See further rules under 'Sales Classes'.
- 6 No entry will be accepted after catalogue has gone to print.
- 7 A relation of a champion exhibitor residing at the same address is not entitled to show in Novice or Junior Class. A Junior is a person aged between 8 and 16 years old.
- 8 All exhibitors should enclose sufficient food for their exhibits to last during two days of the show.
- 9 The annual subscription of the society is champion & Novice €20.00 and Junior & OAP €3.00 – payable on or before 15th October.
- 10 All birds to be exhibited in a clean, standard border canary show cage.
- 11 The committee will be in attendance at the show Hall in order to receive exhibits from 7.00pm to 10.00pm on the Friday night of the show, after which time exhibits will be late for the competition. Any bird showing signs of 'colour Feeding' will be disqualified.

- 12 Novice rules now read: 'Total of ten, best novice in show awards at Border specialist clubs or Border & fife clubs with an unlimited time period'.
- 13 A Judges decision will be final except where fraud, misrepresentation or collusion is afterwards proven. Anyone with definite grounds for disputing an award may lodge a written protest with the show Manager at any time before 8.00pm on the first day of the Show, depositing a sum of €10.00 pending investigation. This deposit must accompany protests against the novice status of the exhibitor. The committee decision shall be final and binding on all concerned. Should the protest be ruled as made without adequate foundation, the deposit shall be forfeited.
- 14 Where a judge is unable to keep his appointment, the classes to be judged by him will be judged by any other judge appointed by the committee. An additional judge may be appointed to relieve any judge over-burdened by a large entry
- 15 Officials only in Show Hall during judging. Show opens to the public at 4.00pm approx. on Saturday. It is not permitted to handle exhibits.
- 16 All cups and specials will be presented at the close of show on Sunday at 3.30pm. No birds or cages may be moved or removed from staging until after completion of presentation of prizes.
- 17 Closing date for entries is by first post Monday 15th October, 2018
- 18 Oat husks, plain canary seed or gold chip sawdust *ONLY* on cage floors.
- 19 Cage labels should be placed on drinker hole side of show cages. Centre of label to be UNDERNEATH PERCH ON RIGHT OF DRINKER.
- 20 Under no circumstances will an exhibitor be allowed to tamper with or deface cage labels after they have left the Secretary.
- 21 Only standard show cage drinkers to be fixed to show cages for the duration of the show with the exception of distressed birds which are removed from staging.
- 22 The Committee's decision on all matters, whether provided for in the foregoing rules or not, shall be final and without appeal to a Court of Law. The acceptance of this rule is an express condition of entry.

WHY NOT HAVE THE BEST SHED AROUND

1	A ticked Bird is one with 1 (one) dark mark covered by a 2 cent piece on the body or up to 3 (three) dark feathers on the wing or tail side by side. Cinnamon ticked birds should be entered in green ticked classes.
2	A fowl bird is one with 1 (one) light mark covered by a 2 cent piece on the body or up to 3 (three) light feathers on wing or tail side by side.
3	A lightly variegated bird is one with dark feathers covering no more than half the body.
4	A heavily variegated bird is one with dark feathers covering half to three-quarters of the body.
5	A three-quarters dark bird is one with dark feathers covering three-quarters of the body.
