* As babies they have garnet colored eyes that darken as they mature. Make note of nestlings with red eyes.

Note: "Yellow/Green" refers to yellow ground color with black melanin. "White/Blue" refers to dominant white ground color with black melanin.

The absence of melanin results in a clear bird, while presence of melanin results in degrees of variegation through "self".

A cinnamon bird could feather out as a clear bird, with no melanin showing, so watching for eye color in chicks will help to identify the cinnamon gene's presence.
