

## The Wessex Border Club      A Short History

The Wessex Border Club originated in the early 1980s as a twinkle in the eye of the late Bert Beeson, who was to become better known within the Fife Fancy. Little happened until the intervention of Roland Jacobs who called a meeting of interested fanciers in the autumn of 1983. At this meeting Roland was elected club secretary, the late Eddie Drohan became Club Treasurer, Tom Sharp, the leading Border Fancier in the area at the time agreed to become President, Phil Green became Show Secretary and Minutes Secretary, and Stan Hunt Acting Chairman. Other founding members included the late Keith Fox, Les Goddard, Percy Appleton, John Holyoak, George Lowe, and still active members of the club Stan Purkiss, Mick Brooks, Eric Windebank and Pete Hickman. All played an active part in establishing the club in the early days. Soon Bob & Ian Candy joined along with Phil King, Dennis Barfoot, & Ron Bridge, Ian became our permanent Show Manager, a position he still holds.

We must at this time acknowledge the large role Roland played in the club for many years; He held almost every official position in the club at different times from the club formation until his retirement from the club in the late 90's. He also found time to contribute to the Border Convention for many years, and along with Stan Keenan, was responsible for starting the Border Convention Journal and its distribution.

Early meetings were held at the White Hart Hotel, Cadnam, but were soon transferred to the British Legion Hall, Bartley on the third Tuesday evening of every month. These meetings normally attracted 25 to 30 fanciers and even had a seed and bird supplies stall run by one of the members, Jock Skilling.

Our first Open Show was held on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 1985 at the Fareham Community Centre, judges were Mr J Wakeman and Mr M Barnett. 434 birds were entered, with Mr D Folkard winning Best Border and Champion with an Unflighted Variegated Yellow Cock and Mr D Winter taking 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Best Champion Border. Best Novice was awarded to D Studart with a Flighted Variegated Yellow Cock, 2<sup>nd</sup> Best was D Wicks, 3<sup>rd</sup> Best was Mrs Bradshaw.

The annual subscription was single £2.00, Partnership £3.00, O. A .P and Juniors £1.00. 25 years on the subs are Single £5.00, Partnership £7.00 and O.A.P. £4.00.

The following year the show moved to the Portchester Community Centre, Westlands Grove, Portchester. Mr D Winters taking Best Border with a Flighted Clear Yellow Hen, with Mr P R Warne 2<sup>nd</sup> Best and K Fox 3<sup>rd</sup> Best.  
1988 the show moved to its present location Portchester Community School, White Hart Lane, Portchester.

The Club changed little over the next 8 years but 1993 was marked by the untimely death of Eddie Drohan who had contributed so much to the club since its formation.

1995 proved a bad year. Our President Tom Sharp had to return to Scotland for family reasons, and Phil Green resigned as Show Secretary to devote more time to his interest in photography.

Sadly with the death of Eddie, Mary Drohan his wife, retired. Mary had supplied refreshments at the club shows for many years along with Chris Brooks and Tessa Perrier. Since then Mick & Valerie Head have taken over the responsibility of the catering and have enhanced the good work started by Mary, Chris and Tessa.

1997 Roland Jacobs resigned his position as Club Secretary and Treasurer to follow his developing interest in old breeds of poultry. Replacing Roland and Phil was a difficult task, but with George & Sandie Lowe becoming Secretary and Treasurer and Terry Cook & Howard Kershaw became Show Secretaries the club survived the year.

Unfortunately George & Sandie resigned the following year due to George's growing business commitments and they were replaced by Peter Hickman as treasurer, and the late Ted Lee as Secretary.

1999 Terry Cook replaced Peter as Treasurer, and the club settled down and began to prosper.

Sadly in 2002 Ted Lee passed away. He left the club in a healthier position than when he became secretary, in addition to his position as club secretary he was widely known in the Fancy and as publicity officer he was able to attract considerable sponsorship. Since then Dave Dodds has been club secretary and the club remains in reasonably good state.

Around this time, with an ageing membership and more officers of the club coming from the Isle of Wight, the monthly meeting was moved to the third Sunday morning of the month.

The history of the club has been like many other clubs, one of ups and downs, but as well as our annual show attracting 400 to 500 entries, we have run a Member's Show and Young Stock show at Copythorne village Hall near Cadnam, both usually attracting a few hundred birds.

The Young Stock show started around 1988 with the best champion being awarded the Den Folkard Memorial shield. One notable winner has been the partnership of Lock & Hochnull who won best champion from 1993 to 1999, a splendid achievement breeding the best young bird in the club year after year. Another notable winner at the Young Stock was the partnership Cook & Kershaw who won the Best Novice 4 years in a row from 1994 to 1997.

The club has had four Presidents since foundation, as previously stated Tom Sharp our first, continued in this position until 1995 and was succeeded by Roland Jacobs who held the post until 1998. He was succeeded by Bob Candy, a long serving member of the club until 2002 when he sadly had to relinquish not only his presidency but also the loss of his birds. Since then Mick Head has been our President and along with his wife Val, taken over as catering managers at the annual show and provide an excellent service.

Stan Hunt has been the Chairman for the whole 20 years existence of the club, except for a short break of a few months when Keith Fox took over, but unfortunately due to ill health Keith relinquished the Chairman's position back to Stan. On many occasion during the club history Stan has acted as stopgap show secretary.

There have been several queries regarding the origin of the name of the club. Wessex will not be found on any modern maps. Historically Wessex was the kingdom of the West Saxons, extending from the English Channel to the Thames and from Devon to Sussex. In more modern times the region of Wessex is considered to extend from Southern Berkshire through Hampshire and as far east as Dorset, to Dorchester (the Area known as Thomas Hardy Country). The members who attend our monthly meeting are drawn from all over this area. Whether Wessex included the Isle of Wight is not clear, but it does in our case, since we draw support from the Island.

2009 sees the club celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary Open show. Sadly many of the original members are no longer able to support the club, for many, old age has taken its toll, especially for Stan Hunt, our Chairman for many years.

The club remains stable, with a dedicated team of officers, Terry Cook as Chairman and Treasurer, Howard Kershaw as general secretary and Show Secretary, Ian Candy remains show manager and staging transport organiser, Phil King is show fund raiser, Bob Turner is show report officer, Pete Hickman is chief steward, Mick Head is the President and head of the catering team of Terry Cook, Jo Dimmick and Alan Thorne, Printing Organiser Bert Phillips and finally Stan Purkiss who are always willing to support the club by lending a hand.

With this team the club continues to prosper, holding meetings every month, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday, and three shows, the young stock show on the last Sunday morning in September, our annual Open Show on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in October and a Members show at the end of the show season, on 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday morning in January.

We would like to honour and dedicate this article to those involved with the club past and present for their contribution to the Wessex Border Club.

I am sure this history of the Wessex Border club has omitted many important details and persons responsible for making the club what it is, that is either not known or forgotten by the contributors, so if anyone has any more details please feel free to add it to our clubs history file and I apologise for omitting anyone who should be included.

The Show Secretary has many of the past results of the Annual show on file and we will endeavour to reproduce as many of the results as we can.

Over the years the show result-recording format has been amended, with later shows having far more information than the earlier ones. Unfortunately there are some years no results were kept.

If anyone by chance has kept a record of the show results over the years and can help fill in the gaps the club would be grateful.

As previously written the first annual show at Fareham Community Centre in 1985 was won by Den Folkard with an Unflighted Variegated Yellow Cock


