

The Border Canary Association has been granted a Licence from the State Veterinary Service to hold its 2024Annual Show.

The conditions of the Licence mean the following rules **must** be adhered to.

- 1. All exhibitors must cleanse and disinfect show cages and carrying boxes before the event and they should be cleansed and disinfected on return home before they are used to hold any other birds.
- 2. All litter and manure within the cages and cases must be disposed of in a manner which does not present a risk of spread of disease eg in sealed bags for normal refuse collection. Any spillages outside the cage must be cleansed and disinfected immediately.

- 3. A Veterinary Surgeon will be on call during the period of the Show and can be contacted should any problems arise.
- 4. Sales are allowed to take place and a record of all sales must be retained. The information required will be details of buyer and seller plus description of bird bought. Buyers must keep purchased birds separate from any other birds for a period of one week.

SHOW RULES

- 1 Only judges and officials allowed on floor of Hall during judging.
- 2 All Exhibits to be "bona fide" property of exhibitors.
- 3 No one will be allowed in the Main Show Hall on the Friday evening other than members of the Committee and officially appointed helpers. The Show Hall will be open from 3 pm to 9 pm on the Friday.
- 4 Exhibitors are requested to have their birds forward by 9 pm on Friday evening or no later than 8.00 am on Saturday, as all birds must be checked in and staged by 8.15 a.m., after which time no carrying boxes will be allowed into Main Hall until Lifting time on Sunday. Judging will commence at 8.30 am prompt.
- 5 Novice rule as laid down by the Border Convention.
- 6 Sales. The Society undertakes to sell at such price stated on entry form and will deduct 10 percent commission, selling classes entry fee £1 per cage. All sales through the Secretary. Sales Birds do not compete for any Specials.
- 7 The Judges award will be final, except where fraudulent practices have subsequently been discovered, in which case any Prizes will be withheld and entrance fees forfeited.
- 8 Only Class Winners will go forward to the final run downs.
- 9 The greatest care will be taken of the exhibits, but the Club will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage from whatever cause while on their way to, at, or returning from the Show, the Birds, Cages and Cases being at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
- 10 No birds to be uplifted before 1.30 pm. on Sunday, except in special circumstances when Show Manager's permission must be obtained.
- 11 If anything arises not herein provided for, or in the usual open show rules, it shall be lawful for the Committee to make a rule disposing of the case arising and their decision shall be final.
- 12 The Committee shall have the right to refuse any entry, and return any fees which may have been sent with the said entry, back to the sender without being obliged to give a reason for so doing.
- 13 Entries will not be accepted from any exhibitor who is a close relation of an officiating Judge of this Show.
- 14 All Trophies, Cups and Plaques are for Annual Competition, except where otherwise stated.
- 15 SPECIAL NOTICE: In the event of a tie for any major award, each judge shall be requested to allocate points in written form for the birds in question.
- 16 Cash Specials will only be paid if there are two or more exhibitors competing in the section.

- 18 All Exhibits to be "bona fide" property of exhibitors.
- 19 No one will be allowed in the Main Show Hall on the Friday evening other than members of the Committee and officially appointed helpers. The Show Hall will be open from 3 pm to 9 pm on the Friday.
- 20 Exhibitors are requested to have their birds forward by 9 pm on Friday evening or no later than 8.00 am on Saturday, as all birds must be checked in and staged by 8.15 a.m., after which time no carrying boxes will be allowed into Main Hall until Lifting time on Sunday. Judging will commence at 8.30 am prompt.
- 21 Novice rule as laid down by the Border Convention.
- 22 Sales. The Society undertakes to sell at such price stated on entry form and will deduct 10 percent commission, selling classes entry fee £1 per cage. All sales through the Secretary. Sales Birds do not compete for any Specials.
- 23 The Judges award will be final, except where fraudulent practices have subsequently been discovered, in which case any Prizes will be withheld and entrance fees forfeited.
- 24 Only Class Winners will go forward to the final run downs.
- 25 The greatest care will be taken of the exhibits, but the Club will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage from whatever cause while on their way to, at, or returning from the Show, the Birds, Cages and Cases being at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
