

This Show is held under Welsh & W.W.B.F.C.C. Rules and Regulations and of The Border Convention Constitution and Rules.

1. The club will pay special attention to the reception and condition of birds and cages being entered for the show.

2. Birds and/or cages found to be in poor condition will be refused entry to the show.

3. The Society will not be held responsible for the loss or damage that might occur to the exhibits and equipment either on their way to or from, or during the show.

4. The closing date for acceptance of entries to be specified in the show schedule and entries will not be accepted after this date.5. No transfers or re-classification of entries will be admissible after the receipt of the entry form.

6. All exhibits must be staged at least half hour before judging.

7. Judging to commence as near as possible to 12noon on the Saturday of the show this is to be printed in the show schedule.8. Judges awards will be final, except where fraudulent practices have subsequently been discovered and proved, in which case the prizes will be withheld and the entrance fee forfeited.

9. All protests must be lodged with the Secretary by midday on the second day of the show, and be accompanied with a £5 deposit. 10. Such protests will be submitted to the Show Committee for their consideration, and they will be required to state if they consider the protest to be proved or rejected. If the protest is found to be frivolous, the deposit will be forfeited.

11. The standard 'Dewar' type show cage with spiral perches are to be used, with oat husks as floor covering.

12. Show labels to be on the right of the drinker immediately under the spar of the show cage.

13. An exhibitor starting the year as a novice will be allowed to complete the year as such.

14. The sales of birds will commence at 5.00 p.m. on the Saturday of the show

15. No exhibit to be sold privately during the show.

16. The Committee reserve the right to refuse to sell exhibits) at catalogue prices, if a mistake proves to be a printers error.

17. Working members of the club will not pay admission to the show, all other members will pay admission.

18. Admission to the show will be paid daily.

19. Perpetual trophies won at the open show will not be issued to winners

20. The closing time of the show will be 1.30pm on the second day.

21. The method of booking birds out of the show will be determined by the committee at a meeting prior to the show.

22. The Show Managers will be responsible for the show and will use their discretion to remove any exhibits and /or cages which are unfit for the show

23. No alcohol to be consumed in the show hall.

24. The Committee reserve the right to refuse an entry which it thinks justifiable.

Only official stewards and working committee members are allowed in the hall during judging.

All regulations to be strictly adhered to.

Birds can be received on Friday evening and all birds must be staged by 11am on Saturday.

> The closing date for acceptance of entries is Saturday 21stOctober 2024.
