No entries can be accepted by phone before 9th October 2023 however if in the event of a Postal strike we will have a provision for receiving entries by phone (Stuart on 07423 401662) on the 9th & 10th October (these will not be in the catalogue though)

Entry Fees: £1.50 per cage. Cheques should be made payable to DBFCC and sent with the Entry Form and stamped addressed envelope for the return of your labels.

Novices showing for the first time: Novices showing for the first time can enter their birds free of charge.

Entry to the show hall: As in 2023 this year we will have a "Speedy Access" to the show hall, whereby you can request a unique wristband (when you submit your entries) at a cost of £5.00 and when the hall opens you can go straight in with no queuing. The wristband gives you access to the hall, catalogue and result sheet. In addition the uniquely numbered wristband is your entry ticket to a special raffle.

Staging of Birds: Birds accepted for staging on Friday 11th October 2024 from 6pm to 8pm and on Saturday 12th October 2024 from 7am to 8.30am

Judging: 9am prompt, Saturday 12th October 2024

Show open to exhibitors and public: After judging on Saturday 12th October 2024. The aim is to open the doors at 1pm and start lifting the birds at 3.15pm (exhibitors exit at 3.30pm with their boxes. A hand to dismantle the staging would be appreciated

Catering: Food and refreshments will be available throughout the show as follows

8 – 11am Saturday Bacon Sandwiches/egg sandwiches and *

12 – 2pm Saturday Lunch (Pie, Chips and Peas)

SHOW RULES

- 1. All specimens must be Bona Fide property of the exhibitor.
- 2. The Judges shall be instructed to disqualify and mark any specimen to which fraudulent practices have been resorted.
- 3. It shall be open for anyone during the show to lodge a complaint against any exhibitor in writing stating exactly what the complaint is, a deposit of £20.00 is to be lodged. This will be returned if the protest is upheld, but forfeited if proved frivolously lodged.
- 4. Should any bird in a class for hens be heard to sing during the show, it shall be deemed wrongly classed and any prize shall be credited to the next in list of awards.
- 5. Doncaster BFCC pledge themselves to make proper arrangement for the care of all specimens sent, but cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to them to, from or during the show.
- 6. Exhibitors shall lift their own birds, but no one will leave the show hall until everyone is satisfied that they have their own birds.
- 7. Any questions arising that are not covered by these stated rules shall be dealt with by the committee whose decision will be final.
- 8. All birds must be in standard cages.
- 9. No handling of cages during the show, except when show manager is in attendance.

Any exhibitor's cages/birds failing to meet the standards cannot be allowed in the show hall.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS ON SHOW DAY

We continue to take COVID seriously we have had to put in place some simple rules to keep our valued members and exhibitors safe.

- 1. This year as last year we can allow officials, fanciers and guests into the show hall.
- 2. When entering birds we ask that fanciers do so in an orderly manner that does not congest the doorway. This will be controlled.
- 4. Whilst not mandatory, please feel free to wear a face mask if you wish to do so, it is recommended as lots of close up conversations take place etc.

We sincerely hope everyone understands that the restrictions are in place to keep all as safe as possible and remain aware the virus is still about.
