### **Entry Options:**

- **1.** Entries posted to arrive by 5<sup>th</sup> October 2025 with return 1<sup>st</sup> class stamp addressed envelope, labels will be posted to you. (Preferred Option)
- 2. Phone entries on 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> October 2025 (07423 401662) a 1<sup>st</sup> class stamp will be added to entry fees and labels will be posted by last post 5<sup>th</sup> October 2025
- **3.** Complete the entry form and take a photo on your phone and either email it or add it to a message by 5<sup>th</sup> October 2025. A 1<sup>st</sup> class stamp will be added to entry fees and labels will be posted by last post 5<sup>th</sup> October 2025.
- **4.** Postal entries received after 5<sup>th</sup> October, the labels will be available at checking in.
- **5.** Phone entries 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> October 2025 will not appear in the catalogue and labels will be available at checking in.
- 6. ZERO entries taken after 7th October 2025

You are reminded that in accordance with the Rules anyone entering birds with a commitment to pay at checking in of the birds, are duly required to pay the amount in full if the birds are not checked in.

**Entry Fees:** £1.50 per cage. Cheques should be made payable to **DBFCC** and sent with the Entry Form and **stamped addressed envelope** for the return of your labels.

**Sales Classes:** This year we will include Sales Classes (95 & 96) to enter birds in the sales classes, enter as appropriate on your Entry Form (entry fee £1.50) These will be shown in the Catalogue on show day.

(DBFCC reserve the right to decline/limit entries if necessary)

**Novices showing for the first time:** Novices showing for the first time can enter their birds free of charge.

**Entry to the show hall:** As in 2024 this year we will have a "Speedy Access" to the show hall, whereby you can request a unique wristband (when you submit your entries) at a cost of £5.00 and when the hall opens you can go straight in with no queuing.

The wristband gives you access to the hall, catalogue and result sheet. In addition the uniquely numbered wristband is your entry ticket to a special raffle.

**Staging of Birds:** Birds accepted for staging on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025 from 6pm to 8pm and on Saturday 11th October 2025 from 7am to 8.30am

Judging: 8.45am prompt, Saturday 11th October 2025

**Show open to exhibitors and public:** After judging on Saturday 11th October 2025. The aim is to open the doors at 1pm and start lifting the birds at 3.00pm (exhibitors exit at 3.15pm with their boxes. A hand to dismantle the staging would be appreciated

### **SHOW RULES**

The DBFCC Open Show is held under DEFRA Licence and to comply with conditions applied, all birds must be presented in clean disinfected cages and birds in perfect health. The allocated CPH Number is to be shown on the Entry Form.

Any exhibitor's cages/birds failing to meet the standards cannot be allowed in the show hall.

Check entry form has been filled in correctly and post the entire form.

- 1. All birds must be Bona Fide property of the exhibitor.
- 2. The Judges shall be instructed to disqualify and mark any specimen to which fraudulent practices have been resorted.
- 3. It shall be open for anyone during the show to lodge a complaint against any exhibitor in writing stating exactly what the complaint is, a deposit of £20.00 is to be lodged. This will be returned if the protest is upheld, but forfeited if proved frivolously lodged.
- 4. Should any bird in a class for hens be heard to sing during the show, it shall be deemed wrongly classed and any prize shall be credited to the next in list of awards.
- 5. Doncaster BFCC pledge themselves to make proper arrangement for the care of all specimens sent, but cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to them to, from or during the show.
- 6. Exhibitors shall lift their own birds, but no one will leave the show hall until everyone is satisfied that they have their own birds.
- 7. Any questions arising that are not covered by these stated rules shall be dealt with by the committee whose decision will be final.
- 8. All birds must be in standard cages.
- 9. No handling of cages during the show, except when show manager is in attendance.
- 10. The judges decision is final regarding the showing and placing of awards.
